HAF provides holiday clubs and activities for children and young people who are:

- In reception class to year 11.
- Entitled to benefits related Free School Meals.
- Not on FSM but who meet the criteria for other vulnerabilities.

Subject to an open Early Help Plan – with a Lead Professional supporting the family from school, Children and Family Wellbeing Service or any other early help partner.


Subject to a Child and Family Plan – Where the family is being supported by Children's Social Care.

Young Carers.

Children Looked After or subject to Special Guardianship Order.

Family in crisis –for example, sudden bereavement, illness or financial problems, refugee families and children at risk of criminal behaviour and/or exploitation.

Children with Special Educational Needs or Disabilities (SEND) or Education Health and Care Plan (EHCP) only if they do not meet any of the above criteria and the family are unable to access alternative or fee-paying holiday activities/childcare/ that would support their child's welfare during the holiday.



Holiday Activities and Food Vouchers

- There is no application process, vouchers are automatically sent to parents if their child is eligible.
- Schools order vouchers for all their FSM pupils they don't send them directly.
- Schools identify and order the vouchers for children with other vulnerabilities.
- Professionals working with families can order vouchers for those with other vulnerabilities by emailing.

- Vouchers are sent to parents by email and text from Hello@holidayactivities.com
 - The vouchers have a link to the booking system.
 - The vouchers are linked to the district your child attends school in – if they live outside that district, they can be transferred by contacting **CFW-HAF@lancashire.gov.uk** At Easter children are able to access 4 days(minimum of 4 hours) of activities.
